A case of edema cured with miasmatic approach though radial pulsation technique: Detail study

Abstract

Edema is the swelling of body tissues by retention of too much fluid. Congenital heart failure, kidney disease, venous insufficiency or cirrhosis of liver might be the cause of edema. According to the three main miasm of homeopathy Psora, Sycosis and Syphilis are related to Vayu, Pitta and Kapha accordingly. By feeling the radial artery pulsation the miasmatic weightage is calculated. By repertory the drug is selected and materia medica is studied to confirm the general action of the drug. With the procedure an old woman of age 55 years is cured from edema in left leg by applying Apis Mellifica 200.

Introduction

Edema is the swelling caused by too much fluid trapped by body tissues. Edema mostly affect legs and feet but it can affect any part of the body. It can be a result of congenital heart failure, kidney disease, venous insufficiency or cirrhosis of liver.

There are three main miasm

1. Psora.
2. Sycosis.
3. Syphilis.

Generally Psora is related to all mental disorders, Sycosis is related to all blood disorders and Syphilis is related to all sexual disorders. The main source of Psora is Vayu, the main source of Sycosis is Pitta and the main source of Syphilis is related to Kapha. Thus psora, sycosis and syphilis are related to radial artery pulsation.

By feeling the radial artery pulsation the miasmatic weightage of pulse is calculated. Then by repertory the drug is being selected and the materia medica is used to confirm the generalized work of the drugs.

An old woman of 55 years old is treated with edema in left leg with this procedure.

Materials and Methods

Radial artery pulsation is judged for determination of Vayu, Pitta and Kapha which is related to Psora, Sycosis and Syphilis. With the help of Psora, Sycosis and Syphilis the miasmatic weightage is calculated. Determining the remedy from Repertory and generalized idea of remedies work from Materia Medica the drug is selected and potency is selected accordingly.

Results and Discussion

The name of the woman: Bina Mandal

- Age of the woman: 55 years
- Sex of the woman: Female

It was asked the woman that she suffers from cold or not for a short interval.

She answered that she rarely have a cold and always bath in cold water even if sometimes in winter seasons usually in pond.

The conclusion was very clear that she is of hot type rather than chilly.

Now her pulsation was checked and Vayu was ++ proportion Pitta was ++ proportion and Kapha was + proportion and body type was hot body.

The edema or swelling remedies available in Oscar E Boericke are: Acet acid, Agar, Anac, Apis, Ars, Dig., Helleb., Prun.sp., Rhus tox, Thyrs.

Now according to miasmatic weightage chart Apis Melifica is having Psora ++, Syphilitis ++, Syphilis+ and H++.

According to the Materia Medica of William Boericke for extremities edematous swelling is a general function cured by the remedy Apis Melifica.

So from that point of view the remedy Apis Mellifica 200 potency 3 drops two times daily morning and evening was selected.

The woman was fully cured within 7 days of the remedy was applied for maintaining the dose.

Conclusion

1. The radial pulsation and miasmatic weightage are related to such a manner that if pulsation changes the miasmatic weightage changes and the remedy.
2. From the radial pulsation with the help of miasmatic chart it is very easier to find out the proper remedy in a short and accurate manner.
3. The function of hot or chilly always remain while calculating the miasmatic weightage.
