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Ferrum metallicum in the management of anemia: A case report of a 22 years old female

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Abstract

Anemia is a widespread health concern in women of reproductive age. This case report describes the presentation, management and outcome of a 23-year-old female with anemia managed with Ferrum metallicum in homoeopathy. The patient presented with giddiness, fatigue and pallor. Clinical evaluation and laboratory findings confirmed Anemia. Ferrum metallicum was administered in standard dosage for 1year. Marked improvement in hemoglobin levels, energy, and general well-being was noted without adverse effects. This case highlights the potential of Ferrum metallicum as a well tolerated option in management of anemia in a young women.

Introduction

Anemia is the blood disorder characterized by the reduction in RBC count, hemoglobin content and PCV. Generally, reduction in RBC count, hemoglobin content and PCV occurs because of decreased production of RBC [or] increased destruction of RBC [or] excess loss of blood from body. All these incidents are caused either by inherited disorders or environmental influences such as nutritional problem, infection, and exposure to drugs or toxins [1].

The very word FERRUM suggests anemia, and possibly, to many of s nothing else: while perhaps few of us associate Iron, apart from anemia, with digestive troubles. We are wrong: Iron, the Stomach, and Anemia may form three sides of triangle. And the eccentricities of the stomach may be causative of most deadly form of "bloodlessness", since pernicious anemia said to be curable, as we recently pointed out, when meat, digested in a normal stomach, is withdrawn and administered to a patient with disease....in pernicious anemia there is deficiency of normal gastric secretions; and we regard Ferrum as one of the great stomach remedies. Sleeps uneasily: is long awake before falling asleep again [2]. Ferrum Met is best suited to young weak people, anemic and chlorotic, with pseudo plethora, who flush easily; cold extremities; over sensitiveness; worse after any active effort [3]. The subject for Ferrum is pale, chlorotic, weak, delicate women, who easily flushes in the face on the least excitement. There is with great paleness of the lips and cavity of the mouth, in fact of all mucous membranes generally [4]. Ferrum met is suited in vertigo on raising suddenly; things grew black; had to lean against something, or fall [5].

Ferrum Met acts mainly on the blood, producing more rapid oxidation with rise of temperature. Due to the disturbance of the equilibrium, causes relaxation. The walls of the vessels dilate resulting in Congestion. Due to action on blood, at first increases the R.B.C. count and red colour causing false plethora but subsequently a diminution of red corpuscles and produces profound anaemia. It acts on gastrointestinal tract, causes weakness of peristalsis, producing constipation. It also causes diarrhoea and vomiting. Due to the action on circulation it increases blood pressure and there is haemorrhage in the intestinal canal ^[6].

Objectives

The objective of this review was to evaluate the effectiveness of homoeopathic medicine Ferrum Metallicum in anemia.

The remedy was chosen through repertorization using Zomeo LAN 3.0. The repertorial analysis highlighting the top 5 remedies are Ferrum Met [8/7], Nux-v [8/7], Sulphur [8/7], Lycopodium [8/6], Sepia [8/6].

Prescription: Ferrum Metallicum 200 [4-0-0] x 3 doses.


Justification of prescription


The selection of Ferrum Metallicum was guided by repertorial results. The prescription was based on key

symptoms such as fastidious, wants to be alone, gets angry easily, craving for indigestible things. So, in totality of symptoms as per the repertory the Ferrum Metallicum covers the majority of symptoms of the patient.

The patient was prescribed Ferrum Metallicum 200 [4-0-0] x 3doses for first 2 follow ups, later for other 2 follow ups Ferrum Metallicum 200 [4-0-0]x 3 doses, water dose. Notable improvement was observed after treatment.

Discussion and Conclusion

Homoeopathic treatment selected according to homoeopathic principles shows effective results. Ferrum Metallicum is capable of improving Hb levels in anemia. The result indicates that there was increase in haemoglobin levels in cases of anemia patients. Therefore, it can be concluded that the homoeopathic medicine Ferrum Metallicum may have beneficial effect in improving Hb levels in anemia patients.
