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Homoeopathic treatment of hypothyroidism: A case report

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Abstract

Background: Hypothyroidism is a chronic endocrine disorder caused by inadequate secretion of thyroid hormones, often presenting with weight gain, menstrual irregularity, fatigue, and hair loss. Conventional management involves lifelong hormone replacement, constipation. Homoeopathy, with its principle of individualization, offers a holistic therapeutic alternative.

Objective: To evaluate the effect of individualized homoeopathic treatment in a case of hypothyroidism.

Methods: A 27-year-old female presented with delayed menses, weight gain, hair fall, constipation, and generalized weakness. The case was analyzed, and repertorial results indicated *Calcarea carbonica* as the similimum.

Results: After administration of *Calcarea carbonica* 10M, given once a month for 6 months, the patient reported marked improvement in psychological stability, general well-being, regularization of menses and reduction in hair fall.

Conclusion: This case demonstrates that individualized homoeopathic treatment can be beneficial in the management of hypothyroidism, improving both physical and psychological symptoms.

Introduction

The thyroid gland plays a vital role in regulating metabolism, growth, and development through the secretion of thyroxine (T_4) and triiodothyronine (T_3) . Hypothyroidism occurs when there is a deficiency of these hormones, either due to intrinsic thyroid disease (primary hypothyroidism) or secondary to pituitary/hypothalamic dysfunction. Globally, hypothyroidism is a significant public health concern, particularly in iodine-deficient regions.

Aetiology

The major causes of hypothyroidism include:-

Autoimmune thyroiditis (Hashimoto's disease), most common cause in iodine-sufficient areas

Iodine deficiency or excess, prevalent in developing countries.

Iatrogenic causes, thyroidectomy, radioiodine therapy, or medications (lithium, amiodarone). Congenital hypothyroidism-genetic or developmental defects of the thyroid gland.

Secondary or tertiary hypothyroidism, pituitary or hypothalamic dysfunction leading to reduced TSH secretion.

Clinical Features of hypothyroidism

The presentation may vary from mild to severe depending on the degree of hormone deficiency.

- **General:** Fatigue, cold intolerance, weight gain, lethargy.
- **Dermatological:** Dry skin, hair loss, periorbital puffiness.
- Gastrointestinal: Constipation.
- **Neurological:** Slow reflexes, memory impairment, depression.
- Cardiovascular: Bradycardia, low cardiac output.
- **Reproductive:** Menstrual irregularities, infertility.

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Severe untreated cases may progress to myxoedema coma, a life-threatening emergency.

Calcarea carbonica Constitution

Individuals suited for Calcarea carbonica often show:-

- **Physical traits:** Fair, flabby, obese, tendency to sweat easily (especially on head and neck), chilly patient, tendency to catch colds.
- **Mental traits:** Anxiety about health and future, easily fatigued, slow comprehension, forgetfulness, desire for security.
- **General tendencies:** Craving for eggs, indigestible things like chalk or lime, sluggish metabolism, slow growth in children.

Relevance in Hypothyroidism

The symptom-picture of *Calcarea carbonica* overlaps with hypothyroidism:-

Weight gain despite normal or low appetite.

Cold intolerance, always chilly.

Constipation and sluggish metabolism.

Menstrual irregularities (profuse, prolonged menses).

Depression, anxiety, poor memory.

Goitre (thyroid enlargement) in some cases.

Thus, *Calcarea carbonica* is frequently indicated in hypothyroid patients who fit its constitutional profile.

Materia Medica Perspective

- **Sphere of Action:** Glands, bones, nutrition, and metabolism.
- Action on Thyroid: Regulates sluggish thyroid activity, especially in obese, chilly patients with glandular enlargement.
- **Modalities:** Symptoms are worse from cold, exertion, and during menstruation; better by rest and warmth.

Presenting complaints

- Delayed menses since 1 year (cycle once in 3 months, scanty flow, and 2 days duration).
- Weight gain of 10 kg in 1 year.
- Hair fall since 6 months (in bunches, < on combing/washing).
- Generalized weakness since 6 months, worse in the last 5 days, not relieved by eating.

Details of presenting complaints

C/O Delayed menses

- **Duration:** 1 year, Menses gets delayed for every 3 months, **LMP:** 22/01/2024
- Flow: Scanty & bleeds for 2days, No h/o odour

C/O weight gain

• **Duration:** 1 year

• Weight increased: 10 kg c/o hair fall-duration: 6 months, hair falls in bunches while combing & during hair wash, hair pull test is positive c/o generalised weakness

Duration: Past 6 months but more from 5 days patient feels lack of energy inspite of eating & on not doing any work perspiration more on head and neck region.

Past history: Nothing significant

Family history

Mother-hypothyroidism; suffering since past 15 years & on allopathic medication

Personal history

• **Diet:** mixed

• Thirst: 2-3lit/day

• **Desire:** Eggs

• Bowels: Constipated

• **Perspiration:** More on face & neck region

• **Sleep:** Disturbed due to complaints since 6 months

• Thermals: Chilly

Obstetrical & Menstrual History

- Menses
- Irregular since one year
- **Duration of cycle:** Once in 3 months
- **Quantity of discharge:** Bleeds for 2 days which is scanty (uses 2 pads per day)
- Character of discharge: No odour, scanty, no clots, dark red

Life Space Investigations

Patient was born and brought up in Bijapur her schooling and CLG in bijapura basically she is introverted person she don't like to express her feelings or emotions to anyone other than her closed ones. She usually don't express because she get fear that what they will think about Her & she get confused easily when someone ask her to make a choice she got arranged marriage, even her husband is good & takes good care and she happy with her married life because he understands Her inspite of being quite. She said she was fine before marriage & after marriage till 1 year, her menses was regular hen she said when all the complaints have started which makes her worry as she & her husband, planning for kids. Then she said her husband is bank manager in Bijapur even my parents & friends lives there but 1 year back they have been shifted here for his work purpose so she have to quit her job & work place. Where she have to adjust to new people & environment & work has become more hectic after shifting here, she don't even know anybody here, her husband workload has been increased after coming here & he comes to home tired & started talking to less with her. She don't like the place where she work past 6 months work has become more for which she wanted to deny but she can't say no as she get fear.

Now everyone are good with her as she is doing extra work but if say no to them they may not talk to she & leave her alone & other than her colleagues she don't know anyone to talk here.

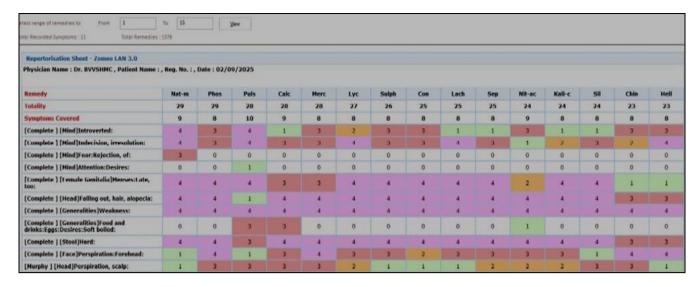

Final Remedy Selected: Calcarea carbonica

The choice of *Calcarea carbonica* was based on the principle of individualization and the totality of symptoms, where both mental generals and physical generals pointed strongly towards this remedy.

Prescription: Calcarea carbonica 10M, single dose, followed by placebo.

Key indications matching the patient Repertorial confirmation

Although remedies like *Natrum muriaticum*, Phosphorus, and Pulsatilla also came up in repertorization, the constitution, physical generals (chilly, obese, perspiration, desire for eggs), and menses characteristics were more strongly covered by *Calcarea carbonica*.

Discussion

The case was managed on the principle of individualization and totality of symptoms. *Calcarea carbonica* was selected as the constitutional remedy due to its marked sphere of action on endocrine and metabolic functions. The patient's mental state (introverted, fear of rejection, indecisive), physical generals (chilly, profuse perspiration, constipation, desire for eggs), and particulars (delayed scanty menses, hair fall, weight gain, weakness) strongly corresponded with the remedy picture.

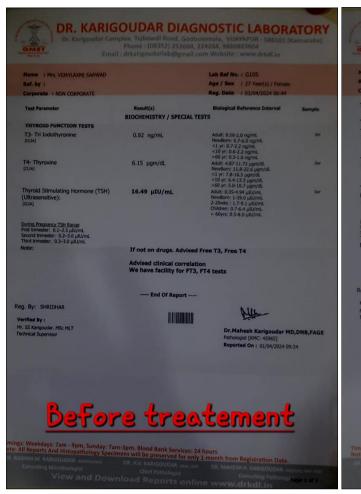

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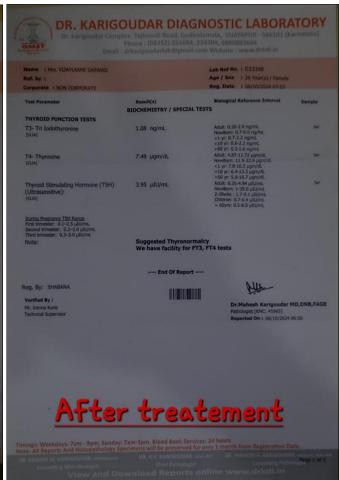


Fig 1: Before treatment and after treatment
