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Utility of homoeopathic treatment in case of chronic gastritis

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Abstract

This is a case of 23 years old female patient presents with nausea and vomiting, pain in abdomen in the outpatient department and was suffering from chronic gastritis. A proper case taking and repertorisation was done, NATRUM MURATICUM 1 M was prescribed. After 2 months of treatment, the patient showed remarkable improvement.

Introduction

Gastritis is a medical condition characterised by inflammation of stomach lining. It is classified based on the acuity of the condition- acute and chronic ^[1]. Acute gastritis is a transient acute inflammatory involvement of the stomach mainly mucosa ^[2]. Chronic gastritis is more common and asymptomatic as compared to acute gastritis, there is infiltration of lymphocytes and plasma cells in lamina propria ^[3].

Classification of chronic gastritis: Based on type of mucosa affected, it is classified into 3 types

- 1. Type A gastritis which involves mainly the body-fundic mucosa. It is also called autoimmune gastritis due to presence of circulating antibodies and is sometime associated with other autoimmune diseases such as Hashimotos thyroiditis and Addisons disease [2].
- 2. Type B gastritis mainly involving the region of antral mucosa and is more common. It is also called as hyper secretory gastritis due to excessive secretion of acid, commonly due to H pylori infection [2].
- 3. Type AB gastritis affecting the mucosal region of A and B types. This is most common type in all group. It is also known as environment gastritis and chronic atropic gastritis [2].

Signs and symptoms

- Indigestion
- Burning and gnawing feeling in stomach
- Sensation of being full after eating a small amount
- Nausea and vomiting
- Belching
- Unintentional weight loss
- Bloating
- Loss of appetite

Case report

A case of 23 years old female patient reported at BVVS homoeopathic medical college and hospital, Bagalkot on date 23/10/2024.

Present complaints

C/o nausea and vomiting since 8 months (on and off) increased since 1 month.

C/o pain in abdomen since 1 month, increased since 1 week

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Details of presenting complaints

- Patient was apparently alright 1 yr back, then she started complaints of burning in epigastric region, she took allopathic treatment (pan D) and got relief. After 2 months she started experiencing nausea and vomiting.
- Nausea: Continuous
- **Modalities:** <after having food, > by vomiting (for sometime again nausea reappear)
- Vomiting: Before vomiting she gets sour eructation
- Character: Contains undigested food particles, scanty, occurs frequently, sour vomiting, vomits 15-20 min after eating.
- Episodes: 4 to 5 episodes per day
- **Modalities:** < after eating, fatty food, outside food.
- Pain in abdomen Onset: Gradual

Duration: Since 1 month, increased since 1 week

Sensation: Gripping type of pain Location: Epigastric region Modalities: < after eating

Past history

- H/o similar complaints took allopathic treatment, relieved temporarily
- H/o haemorrhoids 6 months back- took allopathic treatment got relieved.

Family history: All are apparently healthy.

Menses: Regular, 26-28 days cycle, 4-5 days flow, bright

red colour, no clots.

Life space investigation

Patient was born and brought up in shirur, when she was 6 months old her mother died, since then she maintained strong bond with her elder sister. As her sister pursued higher studies, she felt distant and stopped sharing her feelings.

Education: She did well in school, finishing her B.Com in Bagalkot and getting a job in Bangalore.

Work: In her work place, manager made her feel uncomfortable by asking her to sit next to him. She refused. The next day she was humiliated in front of everyone saying she was not capable of doing her job. This incident left her fearful and worried.

Personal life: After 6 months she transferred to Bagalkot and got engaged, at first her fiance was supportive but when she shared her past experience, he started judging her and told her to quit her job. This made her to stop sharing things with him.



Natrum mur 1M (1dose) stat Pl (4-0-4) ×15 days

Follow-up

Result

After 2 months of homoeopathic treatment, the patient showed symptomatic improvement.

Conclusion

This case highlights the importance of holistic case-taking and individualized remedy selection in homeopathic practice. The patient, suffering from chronic gastritis with both physical and mental-emotional symptoms, responded well to Natrum muraticum 1M, prescribed based on totality of symptoms including emotional causation such as ailments from humiliation, dwelling on past events, and anxiety about the future.

Over a period of two months, the patient showed significant improvement in both gastrointestinal and psychological symptoms, with reduced frequency and intensity of nausea, vomiting, and abdominal pain, as well as better sleep and emotional well-being. This case demonstrates the effectiveness of classical homeopathy in managing chronic gastritis when prescribed on the basis of individual symptomatology and constitutional approach.
