A case report of wart treated by homoeopathy

Abstract

Warts are small growths with a rough texture that can appear anywhere on the body. It can look like a solid blister or a small cauliflower. Warts are spread by both direct and indirect contact, but Homoeopathy has a curative role in the treatment of all types of warts. A 30 years old male patient came to us with a wart on scalp. A complete case history was taken and after repertorization, on the basis of totality and individualization, Nitricum Acidum was given. The aim of article is to show the curability of homoeopathic medicine in the cases of warts.

Introduction

Warts are small growths on the skin or mucosa caused by the human papilloma virus (HPV). The virus infects the top layer of skin, causing the skin to over grow, producing small rough bumps, smooth flat areas or wider patches of thick skin with irregular edges. Visible warts have likely been growing for months before they are detected. A wart can be the same color as the skin or it may be lighter or darker. There are more than 100 known types of HPV. Warts are spread by both direct and indirect contact with mucous membrane or broken skin. Each kind of wart can grow on any part of the body but is more commonly associated with specific areas of the body such as the hands, face, extremities, genitalia or feet [1].

Pathophysiology

Warts can affect any area on the skin and mucous membranes. The HPV virus infects the epithelium and systemic dissemination of the virus does not occur. Viral replication occurs in differentiated epithelial cells in the upper level of the epidermis; however viral particles can be found in the basal layer [2].

Case Record

Mr. XYZ, 30 years old, came to us for a wart on scalp, on date 25 July 2019 with sadness and said how this can cure.

Present History: Patient came to us with sadness and said “can a wart which is on my scalp, can be treated by Homoeopathy”? We have noticed there is filiform like growth in a spot on scalp. Patient has itching sometime which is aggravated by touch. Sometime wart bleeds after scratching for a long time or accidentally touch by comb during combing.

Past History: Patient has wart from last 1 year and he took allopathic medicines both oral and external applications prescribed by renowned allopathic physicians. He had firstly itching in a spot on scalp and noticed there was a papular growth in between hairs. After some days he felt few over growth on itching area and progressively it becomes large.
