Homeopathy in conjunction with radiesthesia: The case of a blind and deaf dog

Abstract

The author presents a case of the cure of a deaf and blind female seven y. o. dog, also suffering from urinary incontinence. This dog was adopted from a shelter immediately before the dog's owner contacted the author for appropriate homeopathic treatment. The treatment was performed remotely (the dog in Ukraine, the author in the USA) using method of radiesthesia. This dog did not receive any homeopathic remedies orally, or otherwise. Homeopathic remedies in their carefully selected potencies were transmitted remotely to a photo of the dog using radiesthesia, in accordance with the principle of classical homeopathy (one remedy per transmission). The day and time of the transmission were also determined using radiesthesia. The treatment lasted four and half months and was successful. Catamnesis is two years. The author has published five papers on this topic.

Introduction

Successful cases of homeopathy in the treatment of animals undermine the arguments of critics who attribute the positive effects of homeopathy to the placebo.

Meanwhile, in many countries around the world, veterinary homeopathic associations have been created and are successfully functioning. Relevant journals are published, conferences are held, etc. This author has more than 30 years' experience in homeopathy and 19 years in homeopathy in conjunction with radiesthesia. The author has published five papers on this topic. The following is a case of the successful treatment of a seven-year-old blind and deaf female dog. The author was unable to find any mention or description in the relevant literature of the treatment of a blind or deaf dog, let alone a combination of deafness and blindness. The only thing the author managed to find was information that "managing blind and deaf dogs involves creating a consistent, safe, and predictable environment, using tactile and scent cues for communication, adapting training with hand signals and gentle touch, and maintaining regular vet care for overall health, ensuring they feel secure and can navigate their world through their remaining senses. Key steps include removing hazards, keeping furniture still, using textures/scents to map the home, and alerting them before approaching".

Materials and Methods

The seven year old female dog was taken by the author for treatment. The dog's owner had adopted her from a shelter shortly before seeking homeopathic treatment from the author.

During the treatment, the author used three homeopathic remedies of plant origin (one in potency 1m, one in potency 12c and one in potency 30c) and one remedy in potency 12c from the class of inorganic compounds (Mineral Kingdom). Above mentioned homeopathic remedies and their potencies were selected and then transmitted to a photo of the dog using an ancient method, which is referred to as radiesthesia in modern relevant literature. A more detailed description of the radiesthesia method and its application can be found by the reader in the works of the author ^[1] and ^[2]. Important: the dog did NOT physically receive ANY homeopathic remedies. The author's complete mastery of the radiesthesia method allows him not only to successfully select the appropriate homeopathic remedy and its potency, but also to determine the day and time when a particular transmission should be carried out. One after another. The author does not provide details of the process of transmitting homeopathic remedies onto the photo of the dog due to its patentability. The only thing that can be added here is that the author did not use any devices/equipment, etc in the process of transmitting

homeopathic remedies. The assessment of the intermediate and final results of homeopathic treatment was carried out based on careful observation of changes in the dog's emotional and physical condition.

Results, Discussion and Conclusion

The author gives the floor to the kind-hearted owner who adopted this dog from a shelter.

So, this dog is in Ukraine, the author is in the USA.

- I want to ask for your help for our dog. We adopted her from a shelter today. She is deaf and blind. As the ophthalmologist suggested, this is due to constant inflammation in the oral cavity (very large tartar deposits on her teeth), which affected her ears and eyes. She is about 7 years old. Maybe your magical method will restore her sight and hearing, at least partially. She doesn't react to ordinary sounds. But she flinched at the sound of a whistling faucet (high pitch). Most likely, she sees shadows. She doesn't bump into all objects. She was in a family with a sick child; the owner died, and the son cannot take care of himself. The dog was taken to a shelter. She doesn't react to ordinary sounds and doesn't bark. She also has a bladder problem.

- **First homeopathy transmission:** November 14, 2020. Zizia 1m.
- **November 17:** She started reacting to being called on the second day after the transmission. Today her ears are better. Dry. Her eyes are worse. A lot of pus. It covers the eye with a film. She sleeps more today. Urine is still leaking, as yesterday.
- **November 19:** The patient is outwardly unchanged. Eyes with purulent discharge. Ears are wet, but she reacts better to loud sounds. She rarely urinates on herself, more often she squats and makes small puddles, and then it drips from her.
- **Author:** That is, the dynamics in this respect are positive. Is it right?
- **Kind Soul:** More or less, yes.
- **December 21:** No noticeable changes yet. But today she barked for the first time, something she didn't like. If you call her very loudly, she reacts.
- **January 1, 2021:** She is changing, but slowly. Her eyes are still unchanged, but she has started to hear better. Outside, she started reacting to barking and other sounds. She doesn't like them and refuses to go for walks.
- **Second homeopathy transmission:** January 31, 2021. ZINCUM SULFURICUM 12c.
- **February 16:** Some changes have occurred. Urine leakage has stopped, although she still urinates a lot at home. Defecation only outside. She started reacting to the front door. She hears it and comes out to greet.
- **Third homeopathy transmission:** February 21, 2021. GYMNOCLADUS CANADENSIS 12c.
- **February 28:** I'm afraid to jinx it. She's become more cheerful. There's definitely no leakage. She's just urinating a lot. We went to the doctor (the veterinarian, S.P.). Her eyes are better. Tears are being produced, the eye is moisturized. We were able to do an ultrasound. The cataract in the left eye is larger than in the right.
- **Fourth homeopathy transmission:** March 24, 2021. LYCOPUS 30c.
- **April 1:** The tear glands have started working. The eye is moist.

- **Kind Soul:** Happy dog.
- **Catamnesis:** Two years.

As is evident from the above, the homeopathic remedies selected by the author using the radiesthesia method, with their precisely chosen potencies, consistently had a positive effect on reducing/eliminating symptoms, which allowed the author to achieve the desired result in a relatively short period of time. The duration of treatment was four and half months: from November 14, 2020 to April 1, 2021. **Catamnesis:** Two years.
