Atopic Dermatitis is an intermittent severely pruritic eczematous dermatitis with scaly erythematous patches, vesiculation, crusting and fissuring. It is a reaction pattern that presents with variable clinical and histological findings. It affects at least 20% of school children and 5-10 % of adults. It constitutes atopy, a condition of altered reactivity to common and mild environmental stimuli. Mainly affects the face and flexures of infants and childrens. In infants, eczema often starts on the face before spreading to the body. There is positive family history or past history of atopic conditions like asthma, etc.

Took allopathic treatment from dermatologist & paediatrician on and off since 1 ½ years but no relief.




Fig 1, 2: Prescription from the Dermatologist




Fig 3: Prescription from paediatrician




Fig 7: Repertorization sheet from Hompath FireFly app




Fig 8: Repertorization sheet from Synthesis App




Fig 9: IgE levels **(**09/03/22)

Fig 10: IgE levels (22/7/22)

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


Fig 11: Pocket Manual of Homoeopathic Materia Medica by William Boericke - 9th Edition - Tarentula (page no - 633)




Fig 12: Keynotes Rearranged & Classified by H.C. Allen – Tarentula (page no. 383)




Fig 13: Keynotes Rearranged & Classified by H.C. Allen – Tarentula (page no. 384)
