Homoeopathic Management

1. Lachesis

Indicated in left side affections. Left ovary painful, swollen and indurated, ovarian neuralgia. Pain shifts from left to right. Suited especially in females with climaxis with palpitation, hot flushes, headache at vertex region. Boring type of pain in ovary. Unable to tolerate the pain. Scanty black gestural flow, she is thirsty, hot, aggravation by Hot bathing, slight touch, Am melioration by discharges, during menses, loose stools.

2. Apis mellifica

Effective in right sided ovarian cysts. Cysts with pelvic pain, scanty flow of slimy blood with stinging pain in ovaries after sexual intercourse. Pain in right ovary with pain in left pectoral region. Stinging, burning, frequent micturition during menses. Desires milk, sour, vinegar. Aversion to Drinks. Aggravation by Hot washing, pressure, warm room, warm bed. Ammelioration by Cold washing.

3. Colocynthis

Left ovarian pain, as if the part is squeezed. Ovarian neuralgia, intense boring pain she draws up double. Severe pain in both limbs with trembling. Restlessness. < From exercise, exertion, open air. Sleeps for longer duration. Severe pain in abdomen. Walks with bent posture applying pressure at the site of pain.

4. Graphites

Violent pain in left side of ovary. Very hard on touching. Tearing, twisting type of pain. Pain increases when exposed to cold or when feet is wet. Discharge of bloody pus during menses, scanty menses, amenorrhea. Aversion to coitus. Obese, hard knotty stools.

5. Lycopodium

Pain in right ovary. Burning, stinging type of pain in back before urinating. Delayed menses with profuse bleeding. White discharge with burning sensation in vagina. Bloating sensation in abdomen. Bloody discharge from vagina on passing faces. Aggravation by evening, 4 pm to 8 pm. Ammelioration by warm food.

6. Bufo

Great sensitiveness in ovarian site. Burning pain in ovaries. Menses are too early, too profuse, Violent cramping pain extends to groins. Hot patient, Desires whisky, pastry, sweets. Aversion to salt. Aggravation by open air, cold bathing. Am melioration by Feet in warm water, massage.

7. Pulsatilla

Menses are scanty. Indicated in suppressed menses, irregular cycles painful menses with nausea. Pain in pubic region. Tearful, plethoric, changeable, nervous. Suppression of menstrual flow from getting feet wet. Painful menses. Violent menstrual colic, soreness in the ovarian region.
